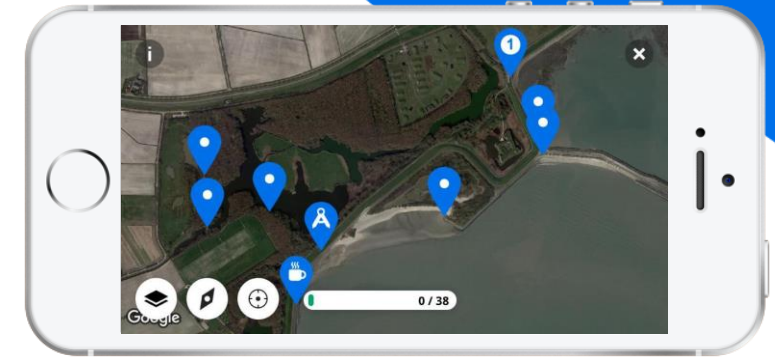


Exploring Rammekens

Tasting sea weeds and more..



Field trip location: Rammekens, Vlissingen, NL

Course: Marine Water Systems
Amount of followers: 30
Type of route: Free route with questions about the marine water system

Short description of field trip:

The area around Fort Rammekens is relatively unknown but has various interesting Points of Interest with respect to marine water systems. The area has sweet water as well as salty and brackish water bodies, resulting in aboveground and superficial water fluxes resulting in different ecosystems in a relatively small area.

Inspiration:

During the trip, the students learned about the different marine water systems in the area and how they can recognize the differences. They had to draw the management type in the sand along the sea and make a picture of their drawing. Also, they were asked to eat a special delicacy of the area produced by the marine system: sea weed.

Form of transport:

Roaming around freely through the area.

Fixed or own time:

Students could follow the trip on their own time, in March 2021.
