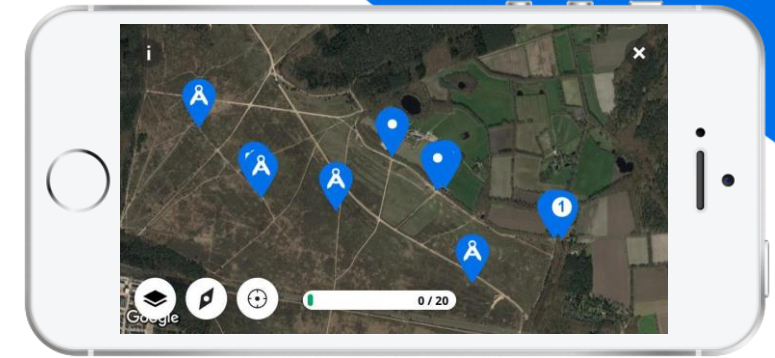


# The secrets of the Ginkelse Hei

What do elevation maps tell you about the history of the area?

Short description of field trip:

The elevation model (height map) of The Netherlands has been updated recently and is available as open source data online. In this trip, students were taken to the Ginkelse Hei near Ede and learned about geography and even landscape archaeology in the area. As the area is covered with heathen, with limited human interference in the past centuries, the history of the area can be reviewed greatly by looking at the filtered elevation models. If you look at the maps you can discover amazing historic things in the area that you would never have seen by just looking around you.. Let this tour tell you the secrets of the Ginkelse Hei!

Inspiration: In this tour the students are encouraged to go wherever they want..

Form of transport: Roaming around freely through the area.

Fixed or own time: Students could follow this trip at a time that suits them best in the period April 20<sup>th</sup> – April 27<sup>th</sup>.
